### **Holidays**

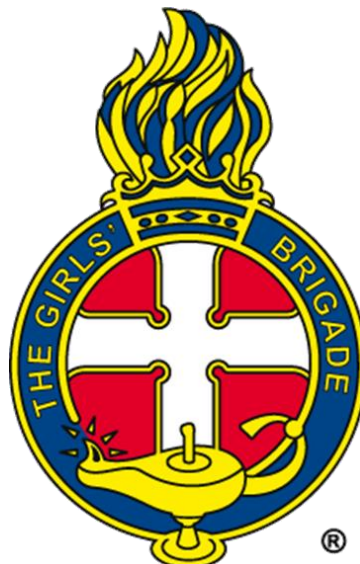
